

6th Meeting of the Development Partners Group on the Sudan Regional Refugee Crisis

Tuesday, 30 June 2026

The UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR) and the UN Development Coordination Office (DCO) are convening a regional meeting of [Development Partners Group on the Sudan Regional Refugee Crisis](#).
